

Opening of a temporary consultation facility for filing Municipal and Prefectural Tax Return.

Period: 1st February (Mon)-15th March (Tue) *Excluding Weekends and Public Holidays.

- For:
1. Those who haven't had their Salary Payment Report submitted to the city from their place of employment.
 2. Those who earn income from sources other than their salary
 3. Those who receive their salary from two or more places
 4. Those who earn income from a business, farm or property
 5. Those who have received deductions due to petty losses, medical expenses, or life insurance and earthquake insurance premiums
 6. Those who earned no income in 2015
 7. Those who received tax-exempt income (such as Disability and Survivor's Pension Unemployment Insurance, Childrearing Allowance etc.)
- Those who receive a total public pension of less than ¥4,000,000 and whose total income from sources other than the public pension is less than ¥200,000 are not required to file a Final Tax Return for income tax, but are required to file Municipal and Prefectural Tax Returns if they would like to receive a tax deduction.
 - Those who have filed a Final Tax Return are not required to file a Municipal and Prefectural Tax Return.
 - Depending on the contents of the filed tax return, the tax office may guide you to the temporary Final Tax Return Form Preparation Facility

Things to bring: → Receipts for health insurance, pensions and medical expenses
→ Certificates for any tax deductions
→ Personal seal etc.

1. Wage earners and pensioners must also bring along their Statement of Earnings slip.
2. Those who are self-employed or farm owners must also bring along their account book which lists their total income and business costs (Please organise and calculate your balance of payments and yearly medical expenses etc. in advance)

How to File a Tax Return:

Please fill out the necessary sections on your Municipal and Prefectural Tax Return form and file at the time and venue indicated on the document (dated for the 8th January) that is circulated to each household.

- During the filing period the Citizens Tax Division will only accept tax return forms sent by post.

Notice from the Iwaki Tax Office

For those who are filing a Final Tax Return for income tax:

- Please fill in the necessary sections of your Final Tax Return form and submit as soon as possible.
- The National Tax Agency website has a feature that automatically calculates the tax for those who submit their Final Tax Return form on the website. The feature is only in Japanese.

Tax filing period: → Income Tax: 15th February (Mon)-15th March (Tue)
 → Consumption Tax: 15th February (Mon)-31st March (Thu)
