Prayers for prosperous businesses as well as household peace will be made. The Yamato dance and Chigo dance, both designated as Intangible Folk Culture Assets in Iwaki City, will also be performed. It is quite common for the bucket carrier to "accidentally" spill cold water on the spectators, so you may want to be prepared to get wet when attending the festival. If you need to see a doctor urgently in the evening or on a weekend or public holiday, the **After Hours and Holiday Emergency Treatment Centre** is open at the following times:

Weekdays: 8pm - 11pm.

Saturdays: 8pm - 7am (next day).

Sundays: 2pm - 6pm, 7pm - 11pm.
