- A. **Beginners Course 1** (8 lessons)

- B. **Beginners Course 2** (10 lessons)
10am-12pm on Wednesdays from 15 May to 17 July
- C. **Beginners Course 3** (8 lessons)
1pm-3:30pm on Sundays from 19 May to 14 July
- D. **Communication Course** (10 lessons)
1pm-3pm on Wednesdays from 15 May to 17 July

Class Fee: ¥2000 (plus consumption tax) for each course in addition to textbooks that will need to be purchased
