#### Evening Street Stalls at Kawamae Station

Whilst the summer festival crowds can be quite overwhelming for some, Kawamae offers a quiet retreat from the bigger festivals in Taira and other major urban centres of Iwaki. Located just 30 minutes by train from Iwaki Station, you can enjoy the outdoor pub, food stalls offering green pheasant croquette, and box-shaped paper lanterns designed by primary and junior high school students for at least 2.5 hours before getting the train back home.

#### Jangara Performances during the Obon Period

One of the many highlights of summer in Iwaki is watching the jangara nenbutsu odori being performed across the city during the obon period (13<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> August). Jangara is traditionally performed during the obon period at the homes of people who have lost a relative over the last year. With over 100 different jangara groups in Iwaki, you should be able to hear the sounds of the jangara's bells and taiko drums wherever you go over those two days.

You can also watch jangara being performed at Kusano Shimpei's Birthplace from 11am for free and the Iwaki Museum of Folklore and Traditional Housing from 1:30pm (fee required) on 14<sup>th</sup> August. Other groups will be performing at various festivals throughout August, so there are plenty of chances to watch Iwaki's traditional jangara this summer.

**Note:** Remember to be respectful when watching jangara being performed outside someone's residence since it is a form of memorial service for the families.
